The role requires strong instructional practice, effective classroom management and a commitment to nurturing the spiritual, academic and social development of students.

Qualifications/Requirements:

- Certificate of Registration with the Ontario College of Teachers (in good standing).
- French as a Second Language (FSL) Part 1.
- Religious Education Part 1 or a demonstrated commitment to obtain this qualification within two (2) years.
- Demonstrated faith life and strong commitment to Catholic Education.
